



Hope for Justice is a global charity with a goal to end modern slavery. As an organisation, we help identify potential victims of human trafficking and/or modern slavery, advocate on behalf of victims to get them support that they need, working with them to overcome trauma and rebuild their lives. We also raise awareness and influence policymakers to improve legislation, and assist businesses to protect their operations and supply chains from modern slavery.

We are the community engagement specialists in the Lancashire Hub. We are available to provide support and advice to any situation where there may be victims of human trafficking and/or modern slavery.

**We can:**

- Assist partners with outreach work, drop-in sessions or individual visits to build resilience and awareness and identify possible victims
- Meet with individuals to offer independent guidance on their situation, and explain their options including entering the NRM or alternatives
- Give people the option to disclose to an independent organisation, and facilitate their engagement with the police should they choose to report
- Use our cultural and language skills and a trauma-informed approach to build trust and engagement over time
- Offer support and signposting to potential victims with any other needs identified

We also have a Lancashire Trainer who can provide free training to any organisation that supports or has contact with vulnerable people. The face to face or online training session will equip participants with knowledge about modern slavery and human trafficking so that by the end of the training they will be able to:

- Explain what Modern Slavery and Human Trafficking is and identify the different types that exist.
- Describe the signs and indicators of the different types of Modern Slavery and Human Trafficking.
- Respond appropriately respond if a victim of Modern Slavery and/or Human Trafficking is identified.
