

The NW Board meets 3 times per year, these meetings are still online.






















There will be space for 4 representatives on these groups from Pan Lancs/ South Cumbria.

Staying Healthy – Janice Living Well – Kim Being Safe – Dene and will each meet 4 times per year.













NW National Campaign Group




You set up the North West National Campaigns Group when the Department of Health stopped funding for the National Forum.


accepted after this time.

If there are more nominations than vacancies then voting will open on <u>Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup></u> <u>February.</u>






