- Must live in the North West. You can only be a representative for your own area like –

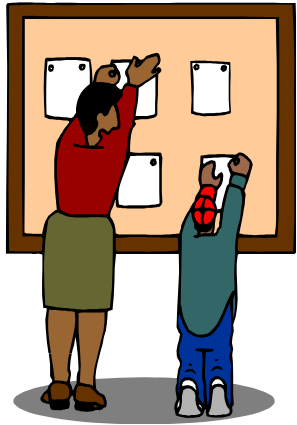
Pan Lancs/ South Cumbria

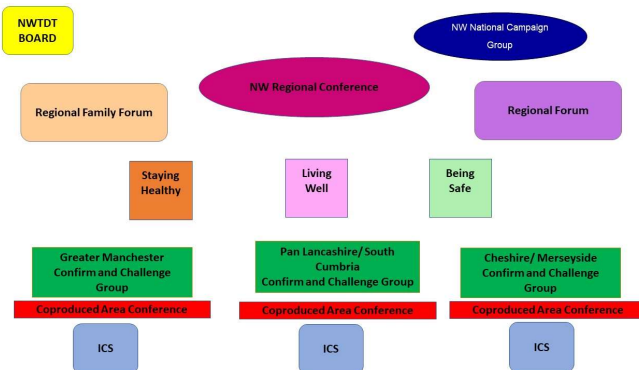


If there are more nominations than vacancies then voting will open on Wednesday 1st February.

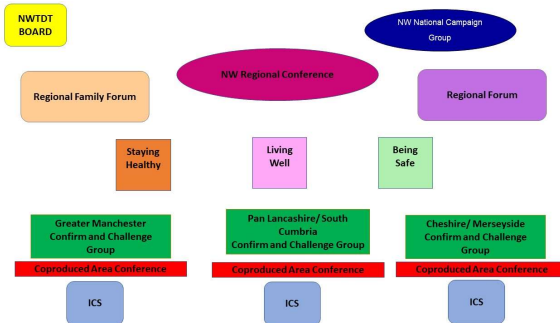

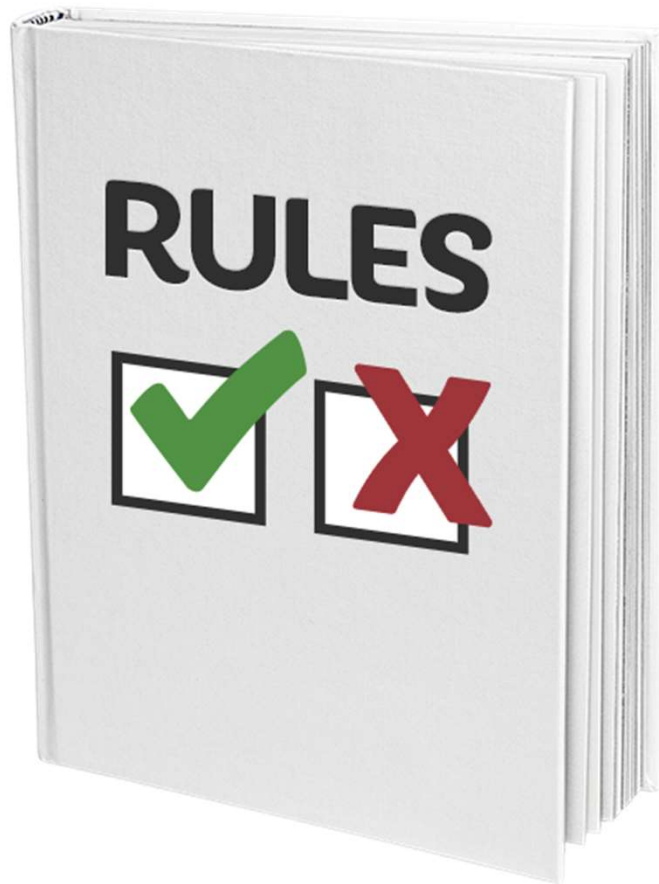

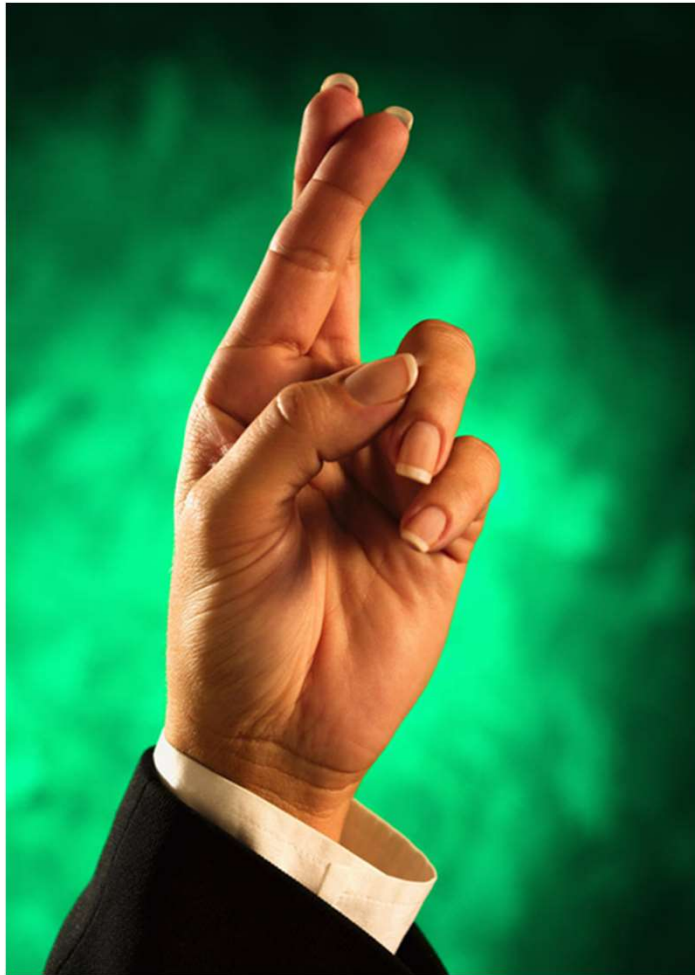
