checked out by your GP.



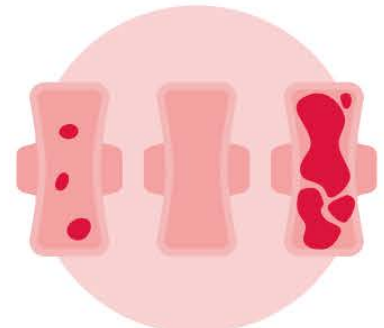
Unexplained pain

vaginal discharge.



Unusual vaginal
bleeding.
